 - Monday will be the last day for Christmas Tree pick ups.
 - Any trees not ready for pick up on Monday will be the unit owner's responsibility to dispose of later
 - Any random trees will not be permitted to be left at the waste receptacle areas after Monday
- All holiday decorations are to be removed by January 10, 2016, pursuant to Section 9.15 Appendix 15 - Holiday Decorations Guidelines
 - Please note, any door wreaths or swags that are not specifically holiday decorated, may remain on the front doors through the end February. Those items should then be removed before March 1, 2016.
